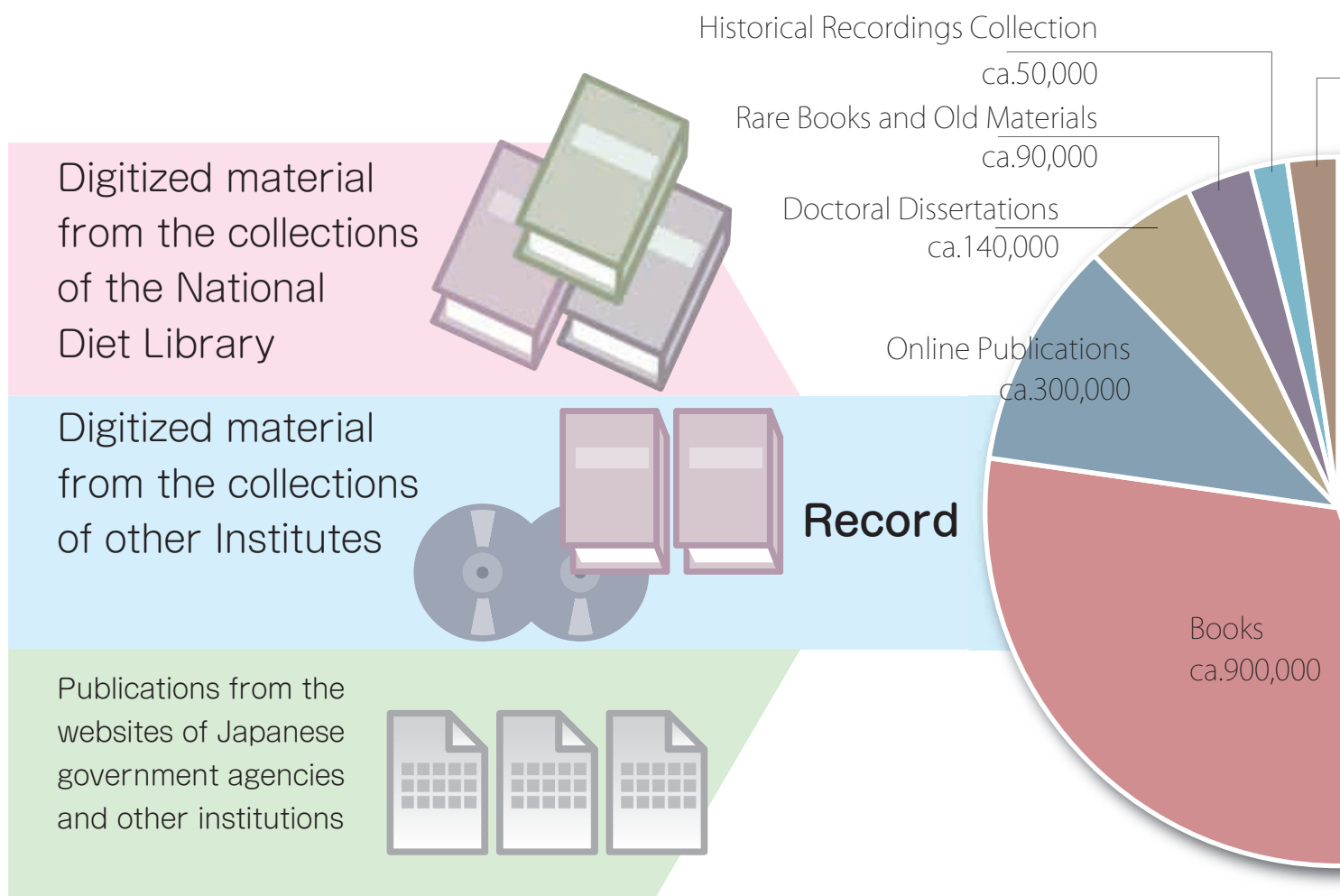

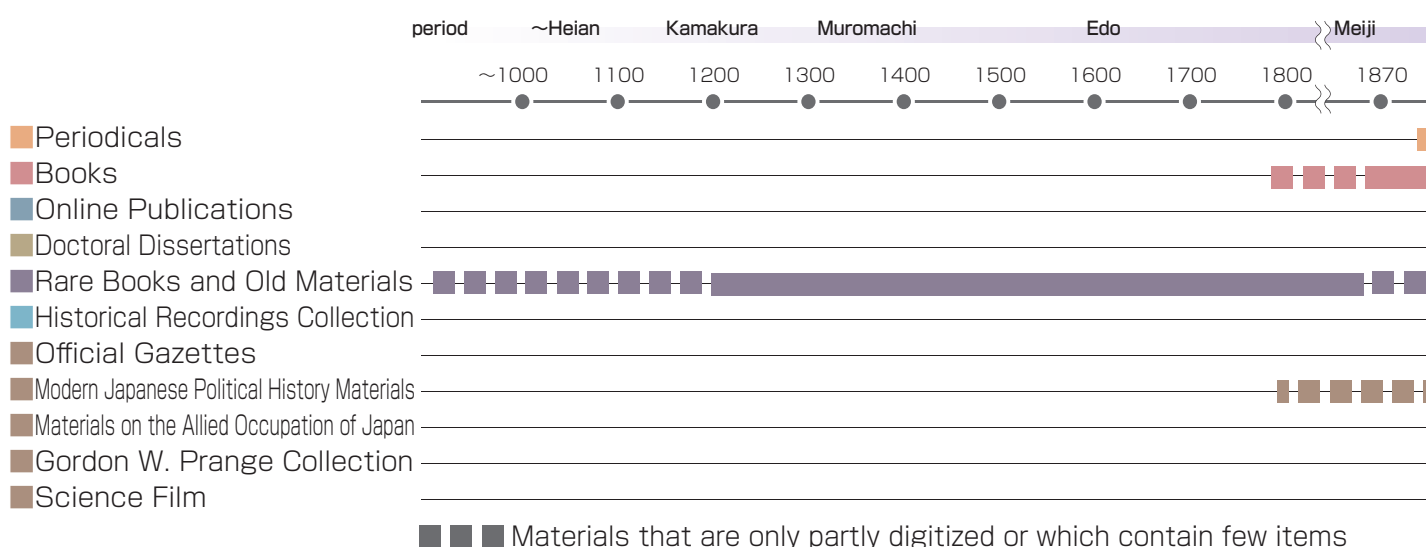

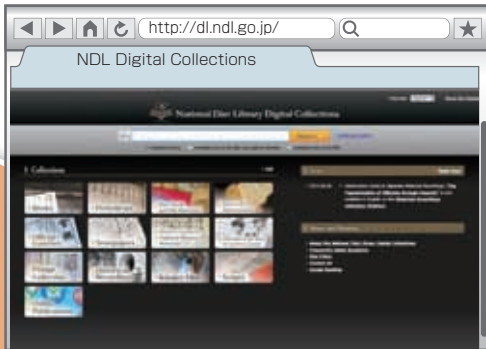


Timeline of NDL Collections

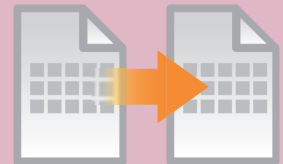

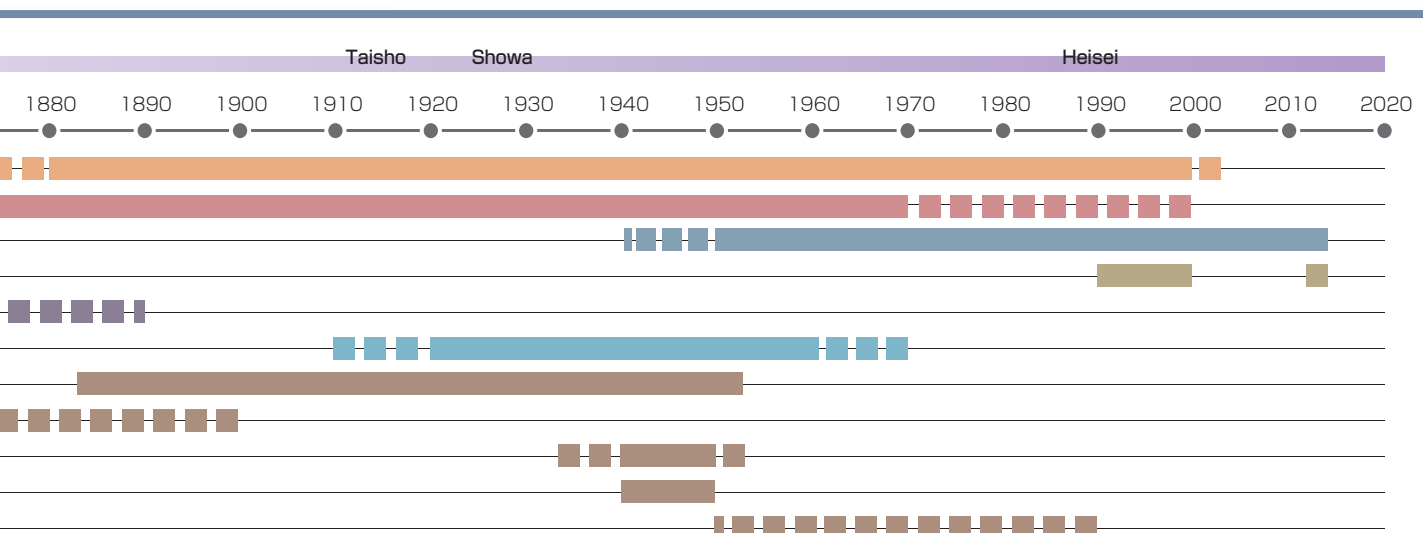

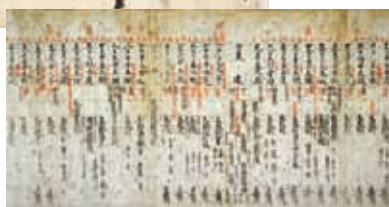

Rare Books and Old Materials



This collection contains roughly 90,000 items, including material written in Japanese prior to the end of the Edo period (1868) and material written in Chinese prior to the end of the Qing dynasty. Some 1,500 materials contain commentaries or transcriptions. Roughly 70,000 of these items are available on the NDL website.

Of these, 15,000 titles have been made available with the authors' permission on the NDL website.

Official Gazettes



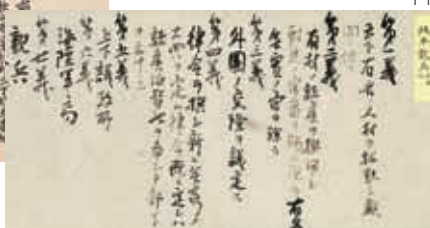
The Official Gazette of the Japanese government was first published on July 2, 1883 (Meiji 16), and issues up to the issue published on April 30, 1952 (Showa 27), are available on the NDL website. The Official Gazette was also published in English from April 4, 1946, to April 28, 1952, during the postwar Allied Occupation and these volumes are also available online under Periodicals.

The NDL collects documentation related to the Allied Occupation of Japan after WWII from the U.S. National Archives and Records Administration and other sources. This collection includes Records of the U.S. Strategic Bombing Survey, Records of the General Headquarters of the Far East Command, and illustrations used in *Reports of General MacArthur*.

The NDL has initiatives in place for collecting and preserving material published on the Internet. Digitized sounds from Taisho / Showa Era

These recordings were digitized by the Historical Records Archive Promotion Conference (HiRAC) from 78 rpm records produced and released from the early 1900s to the 1950s. This collection includes a variety of popular songs, Japanese traditional music, storytelling performances (Rakugo, Rokyoku, etc.), classic music, and speeches.



Approximately 1,100 public-domain recordings are available for streaming on the NDL website, and all recordings in Rekion are available for listening on the premises at the NDL and its Rekion partner libraries*.
