► Established: in 1967 with small collection



Present: shifted to the present four storied building since1984.



► Established archives from 2006 onwards

NLAB consist of: Foreign Language Section, Classical/Choekey Section and Archives Section.



Collections

► Classical/Choekey Texts – 16,100 titles with 1 million subtitles.



► English or Modern Languagecollections -12,624





- Archival Materials-
 - 2400 in printing materials

- 1200 in soft form (microfilming and digitization)





Xylographic Blocks -11000 wooden block & 700 metal block.



▶ Digital Collection- 3797 titles from (BDRC) &4500 titles of Buddhist scriptures with collaboration with Loden (CSO)
