- About 1.8 million materials* available, that are out-of-print or otherwise difficult-to-obtain, of the NDL's about 3.61 million NDL's digitized materials.
- About 820,000 books acquired by the NDL up to 1987, and about 820,000 issues of periodicals published during or after the Meiji period, etc. (Excludes commercial publications and comics).
